- [Christopher Columbus Waterfront Park](#), Corner of Atlantic Ave and Cross St: *Views of the harbor with gardens and fountain; Starbucks inside Marriott nearby*
- [Quincy Market / Faneuil Hall Marketplace](#), S Market St: *Shopping center with many stores & restaurants comprising 3 historic market buildings & a promenade.*
- [Old North Church](#), 193 Salem St: *historic church available for tours; near original NBSS building, open 9am-6pm*
- [Paul Revere Mall](#), behind Old North Church between Salem St and Hanover St: *Brick-paved park centered around a statue of a horse-mounted Revere on his famous Midnight Ride.*
- [The Paul Revere House](#), 19 N Square: *historic site available for tours, open 9:30am-5:15pm*
- [Long Wharf](#), Long Wharf and State St.: *on other side of Marriott, park at the end with views of the harbor*
- [New England Aquarium](#), 1 Central Wharf: *Large regional aquarium, open 9am-6pm*
- [Carmen Park / New England Holocaust Memorial](#), 98 Union St.: *Holocaust memorial with illuminated glass towers & small park*
