- Tape Measure (Fat Max 25' suggested, but any 20' or longer will do)
- Framing Square (Stanley 45-011, Swanson TA-126, or Empire E1190)
- Handsaw (Stanley Sharptooth 15" or 26")
- Carpenter's framing pencils (several)
- Ticonderoga pencils (#3)
- Safety Glasses
- Ear Protection
- Work boots NO SNEAKERS OR SANDALS
- Work gloves
- Loose Leaf Notebook
