

Three-Month Furniture Making Intensive Veterans Association Post-9/11 Benefits Explanation

Qualifying veterans may use VA benefits, including the Post 9/11 GI Bill or Veteran Readiness and Employment (VR&E) benefits, to cover the tuition for the Three-Month Furniture Making Intensive offered through the Community Education Department at North Bennet Street School (NBSS). Total Tuition for this program is \$9,155.

- Upon receiving your email with all the requested information the Community Education Office will share a coupon code for a discounted deposit rate.
- You are required to pay a \$100 deposit to register and hold your spot. This will not be refunded if you cancel or drop the class.
 - You will be reimbursed for the \$100 deposit when NBSS receives payment for you from the VA if the payment is sufficient to cover the cost of the course in full (usually within the first week of class).
- Once you have provided your Certificate of Eligibility and registered for the course to the Community Education Office, the Community Education Office will forward your Certificate of Eligibility to the NBSS School Certify Official (SCO). The NBSS SCO will then certify your enrollment with the VA.
- If you will be using Veteran Readiness and Employment benefits (VR&E), your VR&E counselor will contact the NBSS SCO directly to request enrollment verification.
- You are responsible for any portion of the cost that your VA benefits do not cover.
- Please be aware of our attendance policy. Students with 5 unexcused absences will be withdrawn from the course. If you are withdrawn, the VA stops paying housing benefits.
