WHO DONATES TO NBSS?



The NBSS Fund

Formerly known as the NBSS Annual Fund

The NBSS Fund plays a vital role in supporting North Bennet Street School. Non-profit organizations often use terms like "greatest need," "operating costs," "general fund," and "paying the light bill" to describe annual unrestricted giving. The NBSS Fund is all these things and so much more.

A gift to the NBSS Fund directly contributes to the School's operations by supporting students, maintaining equipment, developing faculty, and purchasing materials, tools, and technology.

Operating costs go up every year, in ways we can't control—like the price of materials and also in ways we want to encourage, like competitive compensation and benefits for staff and faculty, and the addition of teaching assistants to our instructor rosters. The primary revenue drivers we have to meet these increases are simple: tuition and the NBSS Fund.




Which means, robust annual giving at every level helps us keep tuition affordable, scholarships healthy, and our operation strong. The greater the Fund, the more we can support all aspects of an NBSS education, from purchasing lumber and laptops to stocking the student food pantry.


As of this writing, the NBSS Fund accounts for 11% of our total operating budget (about \$850,000 each year). If we are to achieve our goals and ambitions, we need to grow the Fund steadily and sustainably over the next few years, to exceed \$1,000,000 annually. These resources will be absolutely critical to map each year's plan, manage rising costs, support our faculty, and pursue new opportunities. It is a cornerstone of financial health, from which we will build our capacity and advance our mission and impact.


