In the half-day, nine-month program students study with an experienced locksmith in small classes. The program provides a firm grasp of the fundamentals and can enable you to do high-quality work after graduating.

You'll learn locksmithing through a combination of classroom theory, lectures, demonstrations, and hands-on benchwork, surveying, and installation. You'll graduate with the ability to service and repair all types of residential and commercial doorlocking devices. You'll also be familiar with security technology such as electronic access control systems.

The program space includes individual benches for each student, a room for instruction and demonstration, a resource library, and all the major equipment and tools you would find in a locksmithing shop. Classes meet five days a week in the mornings, and during your second semester, you can work part-time while continuing to learn the trade in class.




